For seven wonderful years, Leland pastored the Berean Baptist Church in Shelby, North Carolina. While on a missions trip to visit one of our church's missionaries in Brazil, we were quite surprised that God called us to the mission field.

God blessed us in tremendous ways on deputation, allowing us to surpass 100% of our needed support in only fourteen months.



We spent our first year on the field in language school every weekday, learning how to speak the Portuguese language. At first, we tried to get involved where we could, but one look at Lauren's face tells you all you need to know about our first few months: it was a struggle!

Upon our return, we will be planting a work in the Salvador metropolitan area. Salvador is the capital of the northeast and third largest city in Brazil. This will be a church-planting-church that will be the launching point for planting churches in the 500 largest cities in the northeast that have no Gospel witness.
